- ✓ 8th annual Call to Action breakfast happening Tuesday, November 7, 2017 at the Radisson Hotel, downtown Appleton.
- ✓ 7-8 AM: Registration. 8-9:25 AM: PROGRAM. 9:30-10 AM: Speaker Q&A
- ✓ Recommended for high school age and up. All genders welcome, though our work does target men and boys.
- ✓ The Call to Action breakfast is free for students and their chaperones - and \$15 for others. Registration link can be found on the homepage and the "Breakfast" page of our website www.VoicesofMen.com
- ✓ We also offer a FREE live stream from our website. Additional details on how to live stream are available at our website on the "Breakfast" page. Last year we had over 1,000 people live streaming from dozens of high schools, colleges, and businesses.
- ✓ The Call to Action breakfast has sold-out the Radisson the past two years with over 1,000 people in attendance, including 300+ high school students. If wanting to attend in-person, please make sure to register early.
- ✓ To allow all Fox Valley schools to be able to send students, we limit schools to 30 students per school. Some schools target football teams or other athletes; other target student leaders and activists; other schools open attendance up to any student interested.
- ✓ Seating is mixed so that high school students can sit near working adults, retired people, etc. We group at least 2-3 people who know each other at each table.
- ✓ A light Continental breakfast will be served: Danish, a choice of gourmet breads, coffee, and orange juice.
- ✓ If busing is needed for students to attend, Voices of Men can potentially help secure funding. If this is needed, please email Shannon Kenevan as soon as able: skenevan@goodwillncw.org
- ✓ Voices of Men has a mission of helping end sexual assault and domestic violence by dismantling Man Box culture and building a culture of Healthy Manhood. We partner closely with our community's local sexual assault and domestic violence organizations: Christine Ann Domestic Abuse Services, Harbor House, Reach, and Sexual Assault Crisis Center.
- ✓ The purpose of our annual Call To Action breakfast is to raise awareness about sexual assault and domestic violence, and inspire men and boys to take action to be part of the solution - often in small, everyday ways.
- ✓ Our Call to Action breakfast teaches & inspires in a variety of ways: featured local and nationally-known speakers, videos, poems & theater, music, table conversations, informational handouts, etc.
